
## IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

- 7. This appliance is intended for household use only. DO NOT use the appliance outdoor or for any other purpose than it's intended use.
- 2. Always unplug the power cord from the outlet before disconnecting the power cord form the unit.
- 3. Ensure the unit is switched off and unplugged after each use and before cleaning.
- 4. DO NOT immerse the appliance or power cord in water or any other liquid.
- 5. DO NOT place the appliance or any parts of the appliance (including the power cord) near an open flame or heated cooking appliance.
- 6. This is NOT a toy. Close supervision is necessary when appliance is operating near children.
- 7. If Power cord is damaged, it must be replaced and repaired by our service center.
- 8. DO NOT attempt to dismantle, repair, or modify the appliance. Only our service technicians may do this.
- 9. When in use, DO NOT cover the cooker and keep combustible materials at least 1.5m from the cooker.
- 10. DO NOT leave the unit unattended while it is operating.
  - 77. DO NOT use sharp or abrasive materials to clean or wipe the interior pot, as this will damage the non-stick coating.
- 12. The pot and its outersurface must be dry before use.
- 13. DO NOT overfill (exceed the maximum waterline) the cooking pot when cooking.
- **14.** Handle cooking pot with care. DO NOT put or heat it on stoves.

### **NOTE:**

To avoid danger of electric shock, unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. If the supply cord is damaged, STOP using and bring it to service centre for repairing immediately.


# PARTS IDENTIFICATION



1. Outer Lid	8. Cook & Warm Indicators
2. Steam Vent	9. Heating Plate
3. Seal Ring / Inner Lid	10. Power Socket
4. Non-Stick Cooking Pot	11. Detachable Cord Set
5. Buckle	12. Steamer / Food Tray
6. Outer Housing	13. Spatula
7. Switch Panel	14. Measuring Cup

## **OPERATING INSTRUCTION**

- 1. Clean the cooking pot with mild detergent and rinse thoroughly with tap water.
- 2. Use the other container ( not the cooking pot itself) to rinse the rice. Otherwise the non-stick coating may be damaged.
- Dut the clean rice into the cooking pot with the correct amount of water according to rice package directions or waterline inside the cooking pot.
- 4. Make sure the content inside the pot does not exceed the maximum waterline at 0.3L (fg. 1)
- 5. Dry and lower cooking pot slowly while adjusting the pot so that it fits the outer housing well. Close and lock the lid with the buckles on both sides (fg. 2).
- 6. Connect the power cord connector to the appliance.
- 7. Connect the other end of power cord to the power outlet. The red color indicating words "COOK" will illuminate. Press the switch down to start cooking. When the rice is cooked, the switch will spring up and the red "COOK" words and th orange "WARM" words will illuminate and continue to be illuminated. Please keep the cooked rice inside the cooking pot for 10 minites after the rice is cooked to ensure excess moisture has been completely absorbed.
- 8 Enjoy your rice!!



#### **WARNING:**

a. Aways disconnect the power cord from the power outlet before unpluging the unit. b. During cooking, beware of hot steam exhausted from the vent.
